Purpose of this document

To formalise the procedure should an emergency situation arise.

General Guidelines for dealing with an Incident/Accident

Please note: this is general guidance to be read alongside the Clubs' separate Health and Safety Policy which can be located on the website.

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation. Is there danger of further injuries?
- Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert the first aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries.
- In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services
- Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised.
- Do not move someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency medics.
- Contact the injured person's parent/guardian.
- Complete an incident/accident report form in line with Health and Safety Policy requirements*

Emergency Incident at training / match venues

General:

It is the coach responsible for the session / match that is responsible for making sure that:

- A charged mobile phone is available at all times should an emergency arise.
- No club member should be left alone at a training or match venue.
- The care of any club member U18 must be in line with the clubs Safeguarding Policy
- Club members should not put themselves in danger during a emergency incident
- Emergency services should be contacted immediately that an emergency arises
